SOPHOMORE YEAR

- Ask your counselor about Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Credit courses available at your school
- Plan and set goals for your future. Talk to your counselor about your interests
 and abilities, the kind of school that appeals to you, and what you can
 financially afford.
- Continue to study and get good grades
- Stay involved in community and school activities
- Take the PSAT offered at your school
- Begin SAT prep
- Begin your college search. If possible, start to visit different colleges & universities.

JUNIOR YEAR

- Continue to prepare for the SAT
- Continue to study and get good grades
- Register for Advanced Placement or Dual Credit Courses
- Stay involved in community and school activities and seek leadership positions
- Continue to visit different colleges & universities
- October
 - O Determine whether you will take the SAT or the ACT
- December
 - Begin test preparation
- Spring
 - o Take the ACT or SAT
 - o AP Testing
- Summer after Junior Year
 - o Begin writing college essays
 - o If you are not satisfied with your score, prepare to retake the exam.
 - Begin college applications for early admission and record their deadlines.
 - Begin looking at different scholarships and their deadlines.

SENIOR YEAR

- Continue to study and get good grades
- Continue college and scholarship search
- Take leadership positions in school activities
- Request recommendation letters and transcripts for college and scholarship applications
- September
 - Meet with counselor to make sure you are on track for graduation
 - o Narrow list of college selections
- October
 - o If eligible, apply for FAFSA
- November
 - o Early action application deadlines
- December
 - o Early decision notification
- January/March
 - o Regular deadlines for college applications
- April
 - o Acceptance letters arrive
- May
 - Make decision of where you will be enrolling, accept admission and send deposit
 - Notify the colleges you will not attend
- Make sure you have paid all school fees and are ready for graduation
